

Expression of Interest (Eol) for Verification/Testing of Indian Pharmacopoeia (IP) Monographs

The Indian Pharmacopoeia Commission (IPC), an autonomous institution under the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, invites Expression of Interest (Eol) from eligible and interested organizations in India for verification/testing of draft Indian Pharmacopoeia (IP) monographs to support the development and revision of pharmacopoeial standards published in IP.

Objective

The objective of this Eol is to identify competent organizations willing to undertake verification/testing of draft IP monographs and analytical methods to establish their suitability, robustness, reproducibility, and fitness for inclusion in the IP.

Eligibility

Eols are invited from organizations having adequate infrastructure, qualified technical personnel, and demonstrated expertise in pharmaceutical analysis, including:

- NABL-accredited Government testing laboratories.
- Government/Public Sector pharmaceutical laboratories.
- Central and State Government laboratories.
- National Institutes of Pharmaceutical Education and Research (NIPERs).
- Reputed Universities and Academic Institutions.
- Public-funded research institutions.
- Government-recognized pharmaceutical research organizations.
- Pharmaceutical manufacturers with well-established Quality Control/Research & Development laboratories.
- Other organizations having demonstrated expertise in pharmaceutical testing.

Scope of Work

Selected organizations may be requested to:

- Verify analytical procedures described in draft IP monographs.
- Perform testing of samples as per IP protocols.
- Evaluate method performance and identify practical issues, if any.
- Submit complete analytical data, observations, chromatograms, calculations, and recommendations within the stipulated timeline.

Terms and Conditions

1. Participation under this Eol shall be voluntary and without any financial implication to IPC.

2. No testing charges, consultancy fees, honorarium, travel, or any other financial reimbursement shall be payable by IPC.
3. Verification/testing shall be carried out using the participating organization's own laboratory facilities, equipment, reagents, consumables, and manpower. IPC shall not reimburse any expenditure.
4. IPC may provide reference standards, documents, and/or samples, wherever considered necessary.
5. Participating organizations shall maintain strict confidentiality of all documents, methods, samples, and data shared by IPC.
6. Data generated shall be used solely for the purpose of development/revision of IP monographs.
7. IPC reserves the right to accept or reject any Eol, suspend or withdraw recognition, or modify the terms of this Eol without assigning any reason.

Recognition by IPC

Organizations successfully participating in verification/testing of IP monographs and contributing to the development and revision of IP standards may be recognized by IPC as an IP Monograph Verification Laboratory/Collaborating Organization, subject to satisfactory performance and compliance with IPC requirements. Recognition shall be based on technical competence, quality of submitted data, adherence to timelines, and overall performance. Such recognition shall not constitute empanelment for procurement, consultancy, etc. or confer any contractual or financial obligation.

Submission of Eol

Interested organizations may submit the duly completed Application Form (Annexure-I), along with a covering letter expressing willingness to participate and relevant supporting documents. IPC reserves the right to seek any additional information, clarification, or supporting document(s), as may be required, from the applicant organization.
