(Low to Moderate Risk)



Potential Risks

- Mercury Release
- Allergic Reactions
- Tooth Sensitivity
- Cracking or Breakdown

Precautions to be Taken

- Monitor for sensitivity
- Regular dental check-ups
- Take extra precautions in pregnancy, pre-existing renal conditions & in metal allergies

Tips for Taking Care of Your Fillings

- Avoid Hard or Sticky Foods
- Maintain good oral hygiene
- Avoid Grinding Your Teeth
- Use a Non-Abrasive Toothpaste
- Be Careful with Hot and Cold
- Monitor Your Fillings for Changes
