Potential Risks

- Risk of infection
- Implant Failure or Loosening
- Nerve or Tissue Damage
- Bone Loss
- Improper Placement

Precautions to be Taken

- Maintain Good Oral Hygiene
- Regular Dental Check-ups
- Follow Post-Surgical Care Instructions
- Take Antibiotics as Prescribed
