

Self-Care Devices: Use Right, Report any Adverse Event

Don't Ignore the Signs—Act for Safe Devices!



INSULIN PEN

Used for diabetes management through self-injection.

Report if: No insulin is delivered, leakage occurs, or the pen malfunctions.



PREGNANCY TEST KIT

Urine-based kits used to detect pregnancy.

Report if: The result is faint, false, or not displayed despite proper use.



INHALER (MDIs/DPIs)

Deliver medication directly to the lungs for asthma/COPD.

Report if: The device jams, no dose is released, or the canister breaks.



THERMOMETER

Help monitor body temp. at home.

Report if: The readings are fluctuating or clearly inaccurate.



GLUCOMETER

Used to check blood sugar levels.

Report if: Results vary drastically or errors appear frequently.



BLOOD PRESSURE MONITOR

Track blood pressure at home.

Report if: The cuff fails to inflate or shows unusual/inaccurate results.



CONTACT LENSES

Used for vision correction and eye care.

Report if: They cause eye irritation, blurred vision, or allergic reactions.



HEARING AID

Assist hearing-impaired individuals.

Report if: There's sound distortion, whistling, or the device stops working suddenly.
