Drug Safety Alert

The analysis of Adverse Drug Reactions (ADRs) from the PvPI database revealed the following;

S. No.	Suspected Drug	Indication(s)	Adverse Drug Reaction
1	Polymyxin B	- For the treatment of Infections of the urinary tract, meninges and blood stream caused by susceptible strains of Pseudomonas aeruginosa. It may also be used as subconjunctival injection in the treatment of infections of the eye caused by susceptible strains of Pseudomonas aeruginosa. - It may be indicated in serious infections caused by susceptible strains of the organisms- Haemophilus influenzae specifically meningial infections, Escherichia coli specifically urinary tract infections, Aerobacter aerogenes specifically bacteremia, Klebsiella pneumoniae specifically Bacteremia.	Hypotension
