Drug Safety Alert

The analysis of Adverse Drug Reaction (ADR) from the PvPI database revealed the following;

S. No.	Suspected Drug	Indications	Adverse Drug Reaction
1	Metoprolol	- Antihypertensive agent- Indicated in the treatment of essential hypertension and angina pectoris. - Adjunct to the treatment of Hyperthyroidism. - Additional indication; i) functional heart disorders, ii) Migraine prophylaxis, iii) Cardiac Arrhythmias, iv) Prevention of cardiac death and reinfarction after the acute phase of myocardial infarction v) Stable symptomatic CHF. - Additional indication: For the treatment of myocardial infarction.	Hyperkalemia
